

Cherokee Forest Mountain Cabins - Directions

From Florida via Asheville, NC

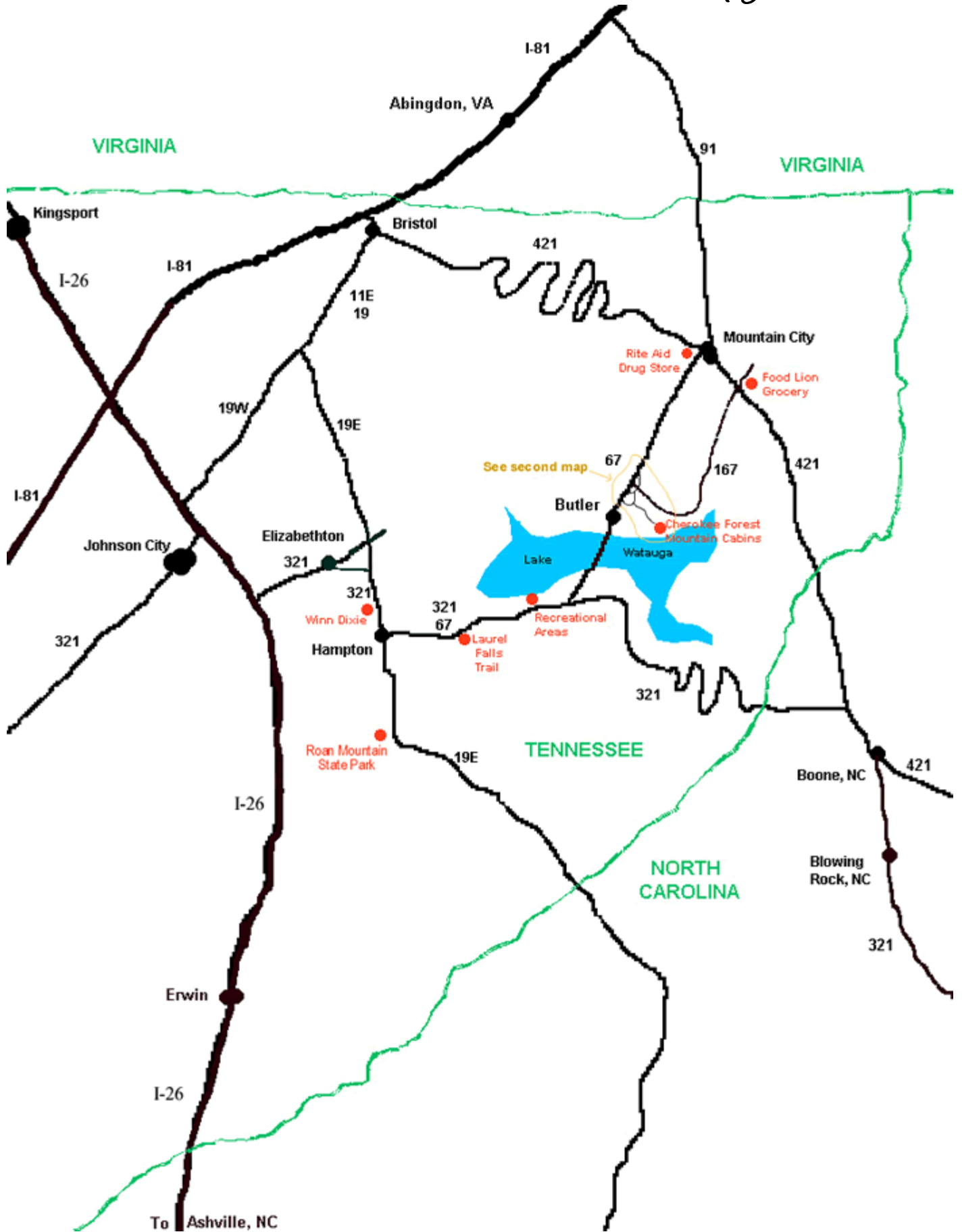
- Take **I-95 north** through Florida, Georgia, and almost halfway through South Carolina. There, I-95 intersects with I-26.
- Turn onto **I-26** and head **west** towards Columbia, SC. Pass through Columbia, SC and continue on I-26 to Spartanburg, SC. Pass through Spartanburg, SC and continue on I-26 to Asheville, NC.
- In Asheville, take **I-26 north** towards Johnson City TN.
- Just before you reach Johnson City exit off I-26 on the **Elizabethton exit 31** on your right. On the exit ramp, stay to the right and take **Hwy. 67 east**.
- Follow Hwy. 67 east through the town of Elizabethton. In Elizabethton, Hwy. 67 splits to the left once, and then turns right about a mile later. There is a traffic light at each split. Watch for the signs and keep following Hwy. 67 east. About 5 miles after the second split you will come to the town of Hampton (very small....don't blink!) near the 17-mile marker. There is a Shell Station on the corner but no traffic light. Hwy. 67 turns left there at the Shell and heads for the lake. **Turn left at the Shell and keep following Hwy. 67 east.**
- This road will take you around the south side of Lake Watauga. About 9 miles past the Shell, Hwy. 67 will split again at the 17-mile marker. You will **take the left split** towards Butler and Mountain City, **staying on Hwy. 67**. You will go over a bridge that crosses the lake and into the town of Butler. Go through Butler (very small), staying on Hwy. 67.
- About 4 miles past Butler and just past the 5-mile marker, you will come to Hwy. 167. There is a business called "Arnold's Auto Sales" on the corner. **Turn right onto Hwy 167. DO NOT SPEED UP!** You will only go a very short block before you turn right on the first road you come to: Doeville Road. If you go past a church on your left, you've gone too far.
- **Turn right on Doeville Road** and DO NOT SPEED UP! You will only pass a few houses and then **turn left on Sink Valley Road**, which will be the first road you come to. Follow Sink Valley Road for about 1½ miles. In that distance you will go up a hill and start back down.
- **Turn left on Grindstaff Road**, which will be the first road on your left. Follow Grindstaff Road until the end of the pavement (less than a half-mile), and then continue along on the private gravel road.
- You will see our sign "Cherokee Forest Mountain Cabins" with an arrow pointing down the gravel road. You will pass a small house with a stone chimney on your right. This is the neighbor's house. Pass that house and continue down the gravel road, which will end at our front gate. On the gate is a sign saying Cherokee Forest Mountain Cabins. Our address number 798 is also displayed. Here, **set your vehicle in low gear**. Don't worry, all cars and trucks can make it up the hill. Continue through the gate on our private gravel driveway. You will probably think this driveway is steep, but you will get used to it. Just around the first turn will be a small building on your right, which is our office.
- The owner will meet you at the office for check-in at your pre-arranged time. **Please do not proceed to the cabins before checking in.** During the check-in process, you will be shown the route to your reserved cabin.

Important Reminder: Please call **423-768-4484** at least one day prior to your check-in date to arrange your arrival meeting. If, on your drive here, you discover that you will be early or later than you thought, please call on your way in to arrange a new meeting time. If you arrive at the cabins and realize you have not set up a rendezvous time with the owner, please call 423-768-4844 and leave a message on the machine. The owner will get to you as quickly as possible.

Please note that most cell phones do not work within a 30-mile radius of the cabins because of mountain interference and sparsely spaced towers. Call before you get into the mountains or stop at a payphone.

The closest payphone to our location is at the intersection of Hwy. 67 and 167 near Arnold's Auto Sales. One block east (towards Mountain City) of that intersection on Hwy. 67 is a small grocery store called "Pleasants". There is a payphone in front of their store. The next closest payphone is out in front of the gas station in Butler (there is only one gas station in Butler) on Hwy 67.
